

GENERAL HANDLING PRECAUTIONS



The batteries are delicate electronic elements and must be treated with care, both handling and in their transport. The fact that they are removable does not mean that they are resistant to shocks, liquids, temperatures, etc.

Any type of abuse will mean the automatic loss of the warranty and the non-acceptance of liability on the part of Torrot.

- Keep the batteries at a temperature between 15-25 °C.
- Avoid Hitting the battery.
- Store in a ventilated, cool and dry place.
- Do not store batteries near heat sources (stoves, Ovens etc.)
- Do not alterate the polarity (positive and negative terminals) of the batteries.
- No immerse the Batteries in any type of liquid.
- Avoid contact with water or other liquids.
- Do not tamper with the battery if it is not authorized.
- Do not stack batteries on top of each other.
- Ensure that metal objects do not contact the terminals.
- Do not handle batteries with rings, watches or other metal objects.
- Damaged batteries (e.g. cracking batteries, broken parts or folded, tucked in or removed contacts) should not be charged or continued to be used.
- Do not smoke or allow parks or flames near the battery or charger.
- Charging the batteries only with the manufacturer's original chargers.
- In case of defects, contact with the Customer Service.
