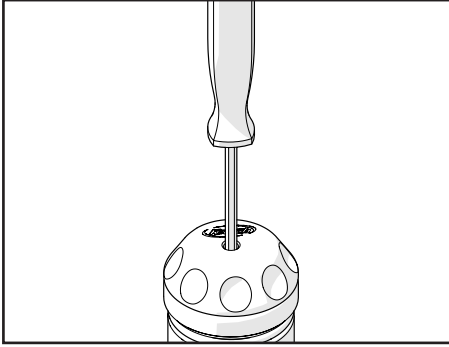
INTRODUCTION

The Tracker front fork cartridges allows the rider to adjust the forks on their motorcycle for different types of riding styles and conditions.

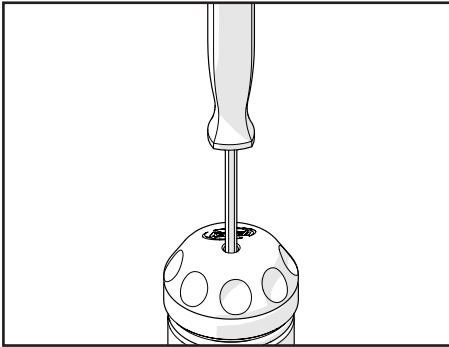

ADJUSTMENT



Compression Damping:-

Adjust using 3mm allen key in the centre of the top cap (left hand leg). Adjustment range is 32 Clicks. All settings should be made from the fully closed (clockwise) position.

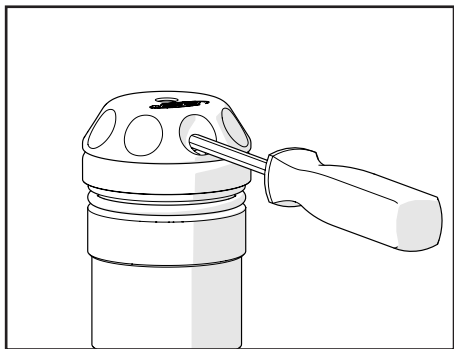


Rebound Damping:-

Adjust using 3mm allen key in the centre of the top cap (right hand leg). Adjustment range is 32 clicks. All settings should be made from the fully closed (clockwise) position.

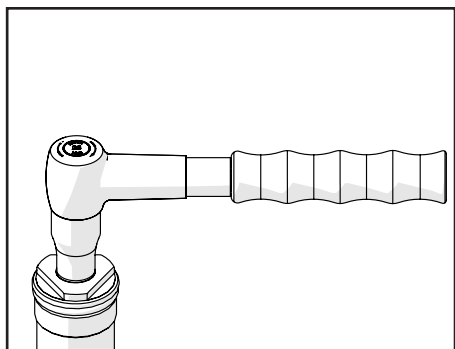
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ADJUSTMENT



Remove Top Cap Cover:-

Before you can adjust the preload, you must first remove the top cap cover. To remove the cover use a 3mm allen key and remove the safety screw.



Preload Adjustment:-

Adjust using 14mm socket on the hex in the centre of the top cap.

Adjustment range is 18 clicks.

All settings should be made from the fully out (anti-clockwise) position.
